10. The MSSC Certified Production Technician course material says "Polk State College courseware". Will this material be provided? Can we get an outline of the course? Is Polk State college conducting this course or is it part of the bid?

The student materials will be supplied by us. The instructor guides can be purchased from xanadu publishing (we will supply contact information) and courseware (power points) can only be obtained from Polk State College. The courseware is free to instructors who have attended and completed the instructor training for CPT program at Polk State. The instructors need one set of guides. The cost of the guides is less than \$200 total.

Polk State is not currently conducting the course but has developed the curricula to meet the requirements of the MSSC program outline and exam content. The topics in the program are detailed on the mssc website at msscusa.org
